Meeting called to order at 5:30 pm showing present: Supervisor Vawters, Clerk Hoffman, Treasurer J. Morgan, Trustees: Bates, Hamm, Swinson, & P. Morgan. Also present: Attorney Young, Deputy Clerk Hurst and 15 residents.

Motion by P. Morgan, supported by Swinson to open the public hearing at 5:30 pm. Motion carried unanimously.

James Glahn the Accountant/Human Resources/CPA spoke and stated that with the co-operation of the Township Board and the Employees the township has been able to stay within a balanced budget. Mary Ban spoke and asked how the royalties are doing? Answer they have increased slightly due to more refuse being taken in at the landfill. Karen Armatis spoke stating that the staff in the water/sewer department are collecting the delinquent water bills by shutting off water, which results in residents paying their bill. Mr. Glahn stated that this is the first time that the water fund did not have to borrow money from the General fund. Mary Ban asked if the trailer parks are paying their share of the water bills. Answer the majority pays in full.
