

**Sumpter Township
Community Development Block Grant
Public Hearing
February 9, 2016
6:00 pm**

Public Hearing was called to order by Supervisor J. Morgan at 6:00 pm. Showing present: Supervisor J. Morgan, Clerk C. Hoffman, Treasurer Bates, Trustees LaPorte, Oddy, P. Morgan and Swinson. Also showing present: Attorney Young, Deputy Clerk J. Hoffman and approximately 8 residents.

Joan Hennessey, Hennessey Engineering reviewed the allocations for the 2016 Community Development Block Grant Funding.

Sherry Olds, resident asked was the grant completely used last year? Ms. Hennessey stated that the funds are still being used, not all funds are used as of yet.

Trustee Oddy asked if funds could be used for the ramps already built at the Police Department. Ms. Hennessey stated only if that was the only access.

Clerk C. Hoffman asked about the Old Township Hall and if the funds are able to be used to replace the ramp there. Ms. Hennessey stated that the funds are used for buildings that are in use.

Clerk C. Hoffman also asked about the funds used for a generator for the Community Center. Ms. Hennessey advised to have three quotes on three different types of generators, a basic, medium and best. Then bring quotes back to the board for approval.

Motion by P. Morgan, supported by C. Hoffman to close CDBG Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously.
